

Religious Education

Our topic this term is '**Creation and Covenant**'. We will be using the scheme 'Lighting the path' and will be learning about and from the Catholic Faith. Our learning will stem from these statements:

- Messages in stories
- The Fall
- Consequences of the Fall
- The first sin
- Jesus in John's Gospel
- The new covenant
- Baptism
- What is the Nicene Creed and how is it used?
- What does Laudato Si' teach?
- Science and religion

God's values are embedded into school life which we prioritise discussing and acting on as well as gathering for collective worship throughout the week.

Computing

We will be following Switched on Computing's program of study. Our unit this term is '**We are toy makers**' and will focus on the children learning how to use a micro bits, designing a toy and developing skills to program movements, sequences and controls.

We will learn about how to use technology safely and what to do if we do not feel safe online.

English

Our core text this term will be ***Coming to England*** by Floella Benjamin.

We will be working alongside the talk for writing process which will include using a WAGOLL (model text), the boxing up process, editing and improving, aiming to use ambitious vocabulary and sentence structures. Throughout the term we will be producing three published pieces of writing including a diary entry, a letter and a biography.

Languages

We will be using Language Nut to support the teaching of French. This term the children will be exploring unit 7 '**schools and routines**'. We will be developing skills relating speaking and listening, reading, writing and grammar.

Music

We will be following the Charanga Music Scheme. This term the children will be exploring the genre of Dance Pop with the focus song being **Happy by Pharrell Williams**.

The Windrush Generation



History

This term we will be exploring the topic of '**The Windrush Generation**'.

In this topic the children will:

- Understand the geographical and historical connection between the Caribbean and Britain.
- Find out about the Empire Windrush voyage and the reasons behind the migration.
- Explore the experiences and challenges faced by the Windrush generation upon arrival in Britain.
- Identify the contributions of the Windrush generation to British society.
- Analyse the impact of the Windrush generation on modern British culture.
- Understand the significance of commemorating the Windrush generation.

PE

In PE we follow the PASS PE scheme and this term the focus will be on tag rugby and basketball.

In **Tag Rugby** pupils will learn to:

- Show accuracy when passing on dominant side.
- Pass with some accuracy on both sides of the body.
- Use a range of side steps, dummies, twists/turns to outwit an opponent.
- Make good use of space.
- Tag others, pass and run with the ball often showing speed and control.

In **Basketball** pupils will learn to:

- Dribble and change directions with control in games.
- Use dribbling to successfully progress a ball forwards in games.
- Link dribbling and passing together showing good footwork.
- Mark a player when they have or haven't got the ball.
- Identify specific things in a game and explain how well they are playing using technical language.

Art & Design

This term our topic is **Mechanisms/Structures**, where we will be combining our learning across topics studied this term.

Science

This term we will be covering '**Electricity**'. In this unit the children will:

- Represent a simple circuit in a diagram.
- Investigate how the number of batteries effect the brightness of a bulb.
- Explore what impacts the brightness of a bulb in a circuit.
- Identify what can affect the function of a component in a circuit.
- Use their knowledge of electrical components to make a device.
- Revisit and assess their understanding of the topic.

Maths

We will be following power maths and our topics and objectives this term are:

Place value within 10,000,000

- Numbers to 1,000,000 and 10,000,000
- Partition numbers to 10,000,000
- Powers of 10
- Number line to 10,000,000
- Compare and order any number
- Round any number
- Negative numbers

Four operations (1)

- Adding and subtracting integers
- Problem solving - addition and subtraction
- Common factors
- Common multiples
- Rules of divisibility
- Primes to 100
- Squares and cubes

Four operations (2)

- Multiply by a 1-digit number
- Multiply four digit numbers by 2 digits
- Short division
- Division using factors
- Long division
- Order of operations
- Brackets
- Mental calculations
- Reason from known facts.
